In this re-imagining for readers and listeners up to 8, we experience the tale from ten points-of-view, including that of the overbearing queen, the spoiled prince, a mother mouse, and a street smart doorman. Princess Lucy is the young lady with the very sensitive back, who will make a better man out of the prince, and Patrick the pea is the proud legume who winds up as a museum exhibit. John Warren Stewig's short texts add novelistic depth to the tale, while Cornelius Van Wright's watercolor and pencil illustrations blend fine draftsmanship and expressive gestures. 32.
