

No less successful than *Les Rivales* was a comedy by the author of the disastrously unsuccessful *Arijvfiifle* of a few months before. *Le Pedant Jbu*, as it was called, had two noteworthy features. It was written in P1-Se, and a peasant in the piece, contrary to all precedent, was made to speak in the jargon of his...
