When we stop at that point to begin the Litany, the custom is universal not to put in the grace of our Lord, but either with or without a hymn, to pass at once to the first sentence of the Litany. But I find that when, instead of the Litany, the Order for Holy Communion is then to be taken up, most clergymen mark the pause by saying, The grace of our Lord, etc. It is wrong. That...
